• **People & Culture:** In a <u>June 22nd message</u> to all campus staff, AVC Eugene Whitlock highlighted that all individuals hired **ON or AFTER March 20**, **2020**, who had their work authorization documentation verified with a video appointment need to take action to bring their work authorization into compliance now that the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services is ending remote verification documentation. There is a very tight timeline for the campus to come into compliance, so please work with your Berkeley Regional Services (BRS) partner if you or an employee you supervise needs to be re-verified.

## Athletics

- Cal's men's rowing team won its second consecutive national title at the International Rowing Association National Championships in early June. The Bears swept all four championship races for the first time in program history, and won their 19th national crown overall. Scott Frandsen was named the National Coach of the Year after the season.
- Cal Athletics also wrapped up its year-long celebration of the 50th anniversary of Title IX, the landmark legislation enacted by the U.S. Congress in 1972 that prohibits discrimination based on sex in education programs or activities. Each team in the athletic department dedicated one home event to the celebration and honored several current and former female student-athletes.
