We may be just in the early days of the summer and the leaves have not yet all turned golden, but it's not too early to be thinking about the spring semester. In fact, the Schedule of Classes for Spring 2024 is set to be released this Sunday, September 24th. The full schedule of the <u>Enrollment Calendars</u> is available now. Phase 1 Enrollment for Continuing Students will open on Monday, October, 16th. See the "Highlights" section below for more details.

Also in thinking ahead to the spring, now is the time to be planning for the 10th annual Big Give, starting at 9:00 p.m. on March 13th for a 24-hour period through 9:00 p.m. on March 14th. Open to all campus departments, this is an excellent opportunity to do concentrated fundraising for your core or special project needs. A **Big Give Kick-off session via Zoom** is scheduled for Wednesday, October 18 from 11:00 a.m. to noon. This is a great opportunity for those new to Big Give to learn the basics, as well as for veterans to get an update on what's new for 2024. If you aren't already, consider joining the **Big Give Google** Group to stay up to date on the latest news and planning in the lead-up to March. As an update on one of the key initiatives out of the EVCP's office, the <u>Reducing Bureaucratic Burden Task</u> <u>Force</u> has now completed its work in assessing the bureaucratic landscape, identifying critical areas that people are finding challenging, and has laid out suggested paths forward for achieving solutions. In combination with 800+ responses provided from across campus, the task force has produced its <u>final</u> <u>report</u>. Last month, EVCP Hermalin shared his insights on reducing the bureaucratic burden during a <u>Campus Conversation</u>, and further updates on these efforts across campus are shared on the <u>reducing</u> <u>bureaucracy website</u>. We are very much interested in learning about your efforts. Please continue to share your unit's process improvement efforts with us by submitting this short form.

In case you missed it, the deadline to submit nominations for the <u>2024 Peter E. Haas Public Service Award</u> has been extended to **October 16**, **2023.** Annually this award goes to a Berkeley alum in recognition of their profound impact in one of four areas: community and social service, health care, education, or the environment. # Athletics

- Cal Athletics will spend this football season celebrating the <u>100-year anniversary of California</u>. <u>Memorial Stadium</u>. Built in 1923 and dedicated to students, alumni and other Californians who lost their lives in World War I, the facility has played host to a slew of memorable moments during the past century. There are several promotions planned to recognize the anniversary during Cal home football games this season, including a halftime drone show to honor the occasion on Sept. 9 vs. Auburn; a commemorative pin and coin giveaway on Sept. 16 against Idaho and a stadium replica giveaway against Washington State on Nov. 11.
- Cal Athletics hired Justin Allegri as its new play-by-play radio announcer for football and men's basketball. For football, Allegri replaces legendary Joe Starkey, who was the Voice of the Bears for 48 years before retiring following last season.
- Camryn Rogers, a former Cal standout who graduated in 2022, became the first Cal track & field athlete to win a World Championship when she took the women's hammer throw title at the 2023 World Athletics Championships in Budapest, Hungary. Rogers won the NCAA championship in the hammer throw three straight times during her time at Cal, becoming only the second athlete ever to accomplish that feat.
